The new Flux winter designs are low technology, re-printed and trashed. With the use of iron-on letters, old transfers and bad printing techniques, the range is anti-designed!

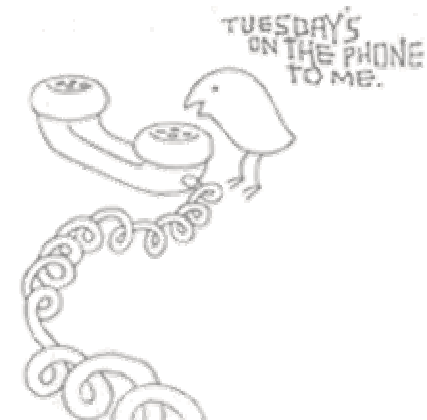


New Drawing... The line fell off the Page

New Drawing... The line fell off the page brings together sixteen artists from Europe, Korea and Australia. The exhibition focuses on contemporary drawing and explores the medium beyond the traditional use of line on paper. Recent works by young artists have been sourced from the fields of art, design and fashion. Using unexpected materials such as dust, light, thread and wood, many have made a departure from the usual parameters of the page.

Curated by Tara D'Cruz-Noble & Emil Goh, New Drawing is a parallel program of the 2004 Biennale of Sydney.
